

**Homeless Prevention Program (HPP) Annual Report
July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010**

The Homeless Prevention Program (HPP) is administered By the Maryland Department of Human Resources (DHR) Office of Grants Management (OGM). The program funds provide grants or loans to households facing an imminent eviction. The HPP also provides relocation assistance to prevent homelessness. In some jurisdictions, the HPP funds support counselors who work with tenants and landlords to prevent evictions. By providing grants, tenant landlord mediation or linkages to resources, the program helps families and individuals, who are at risk for eviction, to stay in their homes. The DHR OGM allocates the HPP funds to community provider agencies through the Local Departments of Social Services in 24 Maryland jurisdictions.

The attached table summarizes the HPP services provided to Maryland families during State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2010:
